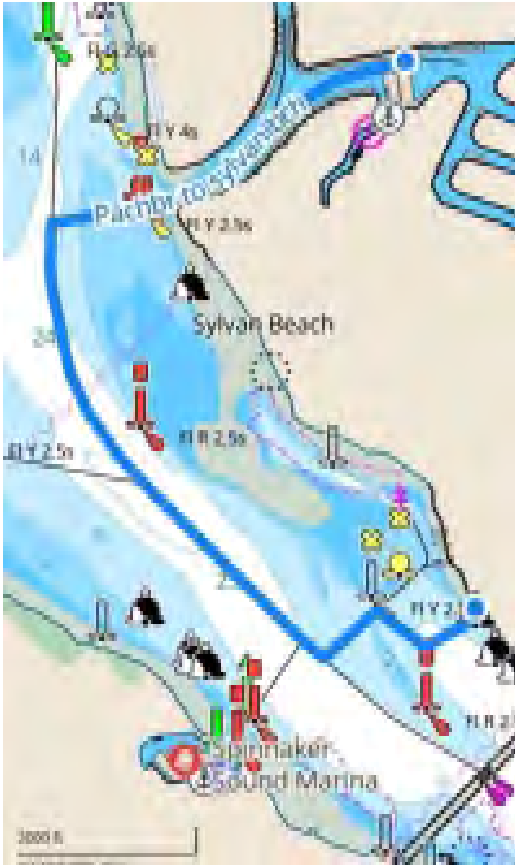

- Proceed towards beach for starboard rounding the orange buoy 1 near the beach.
- Proceed south, parallel to the beach and take orange buoy 2 to starboard.
- Head West out from beach and take the red channel marker to starboard
- Complete the circuit taking orange buoy (3) to starboard
- Proceed carefully to anchor west of a line between the 1 & 2 orange buoys or beach your boat on Sylvan Beach. Enjoy showing your boat!

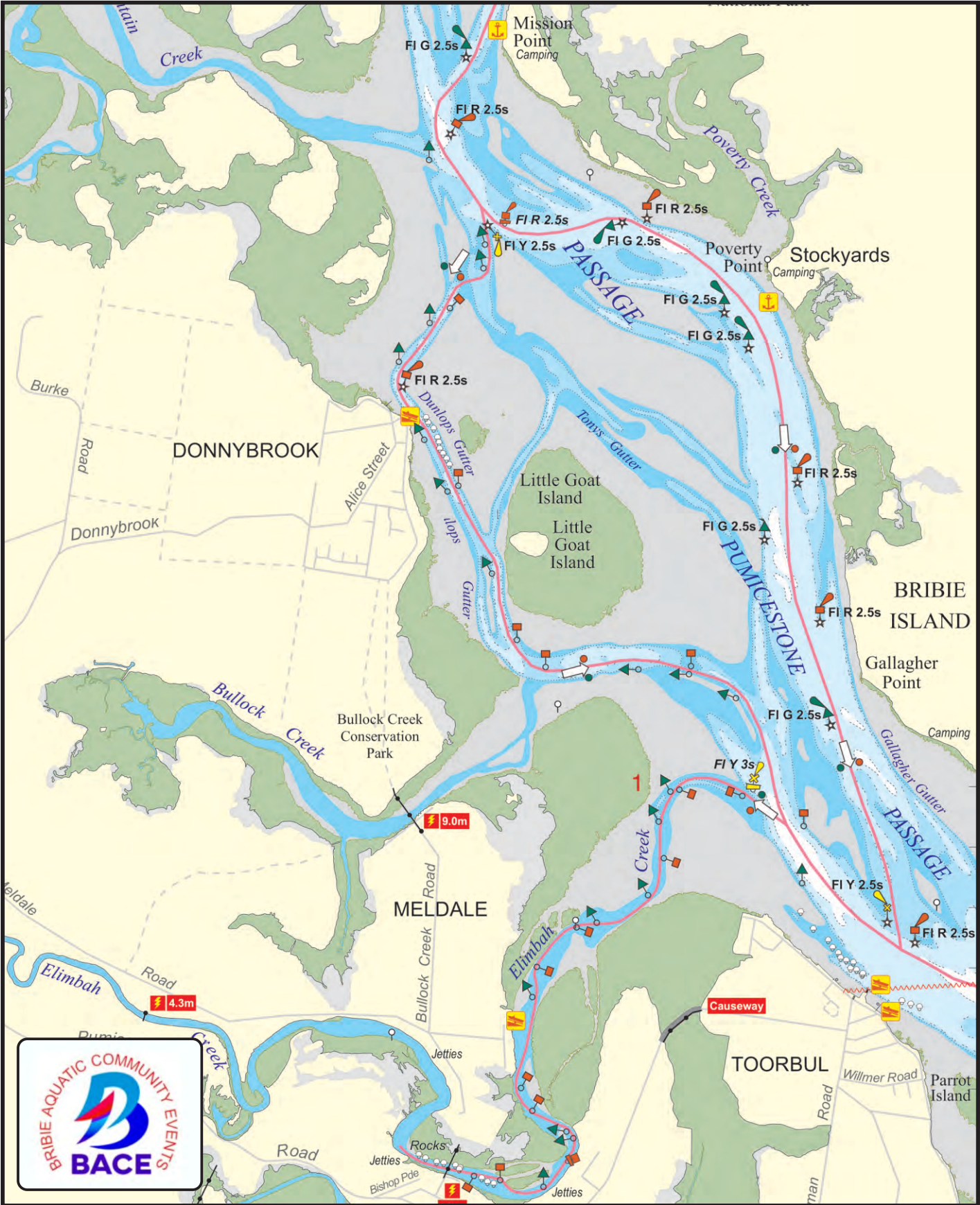

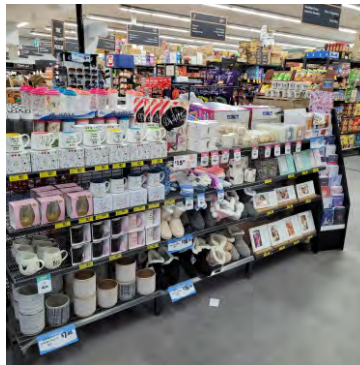
